Simultaneously, World Book Day was a festive part of the assembly. Students presented a foot tapping number displaying the importance of reading.




This dual-themed assembly was not only educational but also a celebration of learning and community health consciousness. It reinforced the power of knowledge and the importance of global health awareness among our students.

EMAC INTERNATIONAL INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY DAY


