GRADE: NURSERY- II

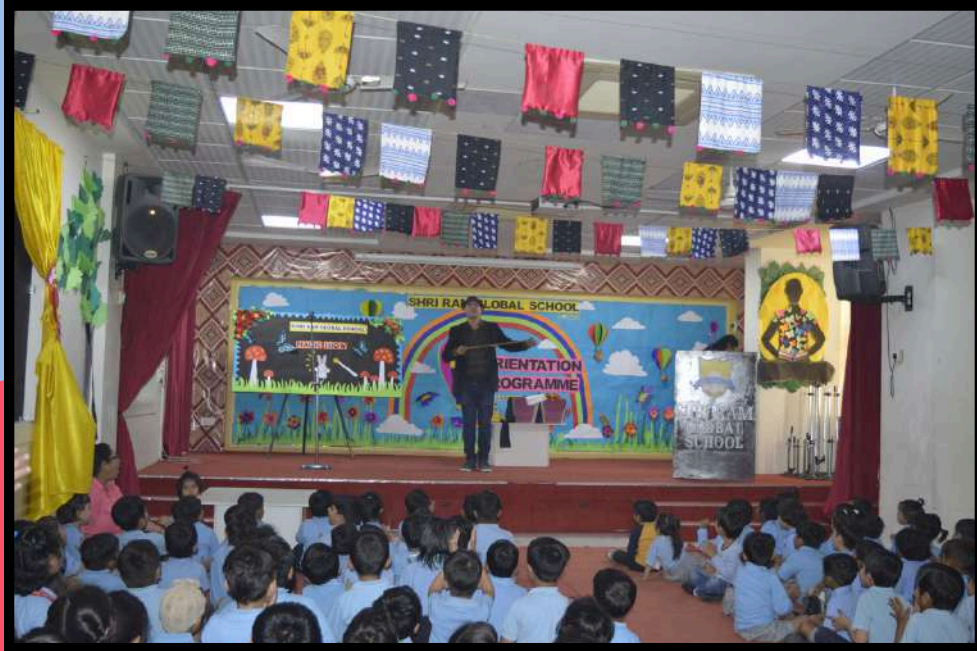

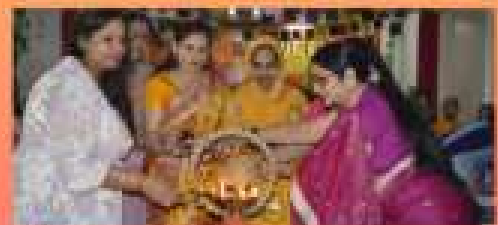


MOTHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

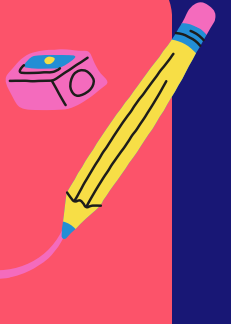

As a part of the Subject Enrichment Activity, Class X students were divided into groups to create PowerPoint presentations on the historical background of chapters from their English textbook.

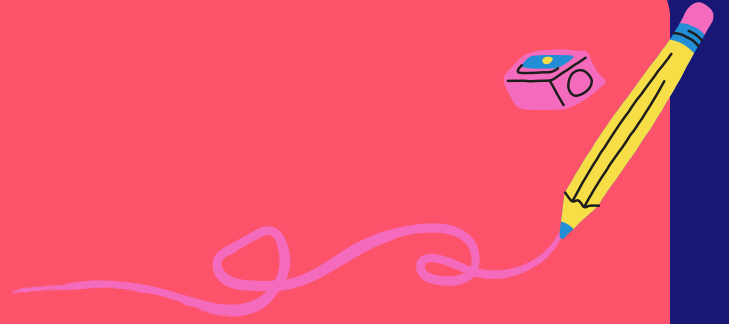

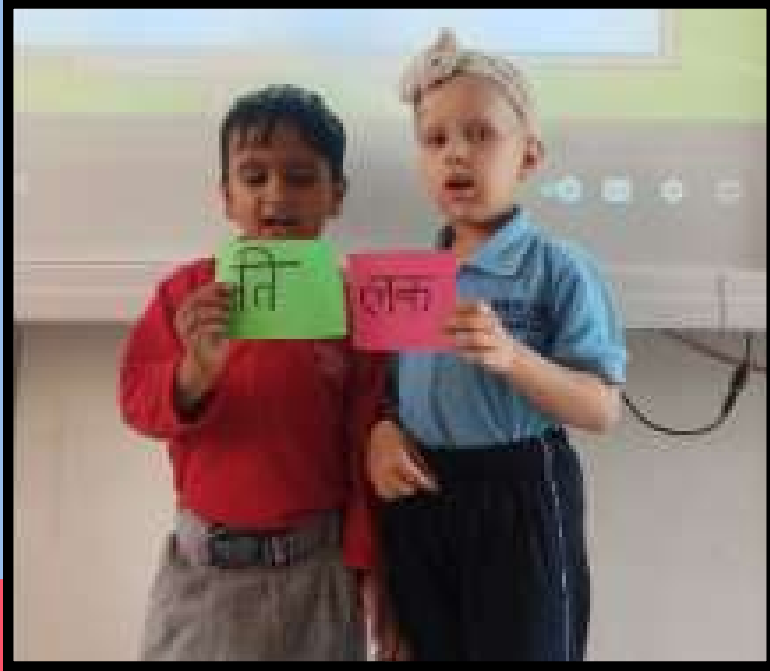
इ की मात्रा

G-20 क्या है?

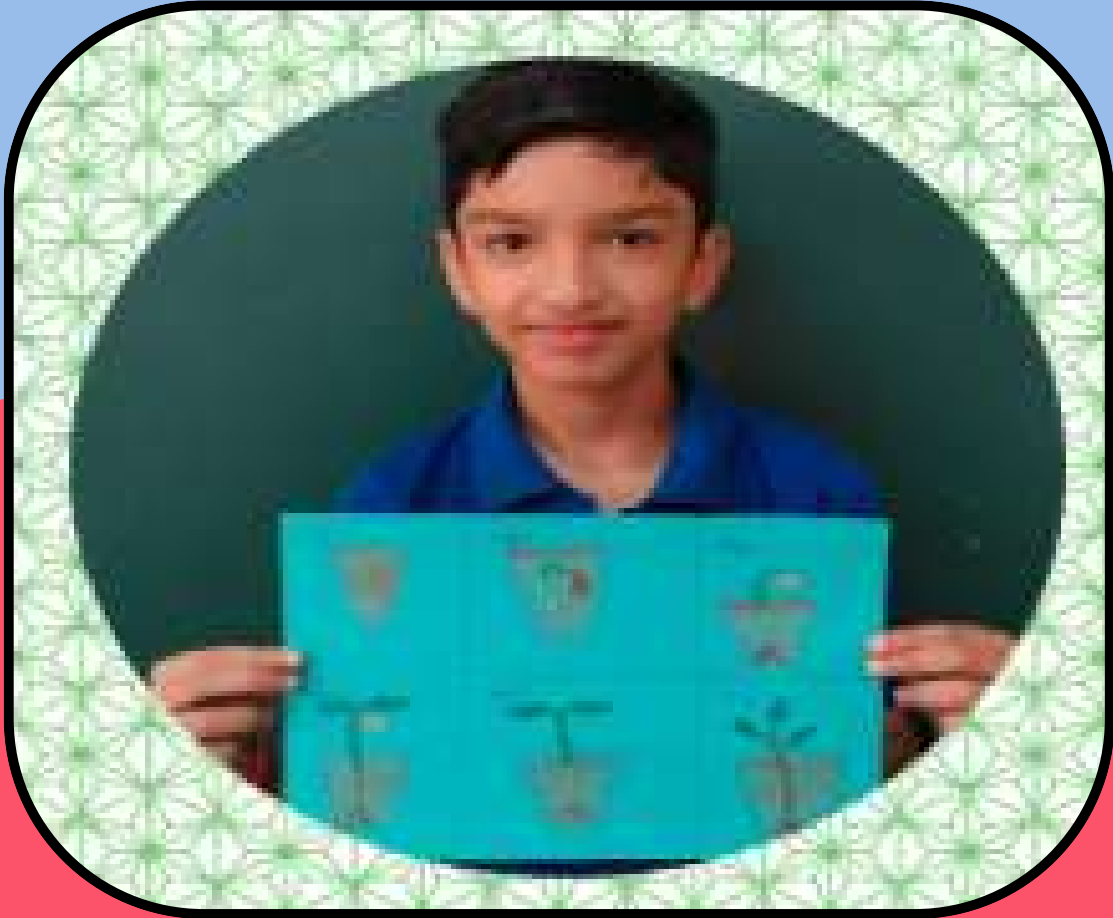


“A Closer Look at Leaves”

Exploring Plant Diversity Through a Herbarium File

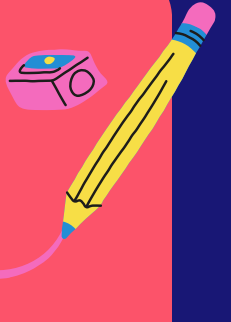
Grade VI students recently engaged in a hands-on science project by creating a Herbarium File, deepening their understanding of Diversity in Living Organisms from Chapter 2. This activity helped them observe how plants vary in structure, habitat, and function, reinforcing key concepts of biodiversity.



Through collecting and documenting different plant leaves, students learned to classify organisms into categories such as trees, shrubs, herbs, climbers, and creepers. By identifying scientific and common names, they understood the importance of taxonomy and classification in science.

Moreover, studying plants' roles—whether in oxygen production, medicine, or food—encouraged an appreciation for their ecological significance. The process of pressing and preserving leaves also demonstrated real-world scientific techniques.

This project instilled curiosity, observation skills, and environmental awareness, making learning experiential and meaningful. It strengthened their understanding of plant diversity and emphasized the interconnectedness of all living organisms in an ecosystem.

MAP BASED ACTIVITY: THE SEVEN SISTER STATES

Without using any readymade maps, they carefully drew the map of Northeast India in their notebooks, marked the boundaries, and labeled the seven states—Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, and Tripura. They used different colours to highlight each state, showing creativity and attention to detail. Through this activity, students learned the names, locations, and shapes of the northeastern states. The objective was to develop map-drawing skills, improve geographical understanding, and encourage visual learning in a fun and engaging way.

"The World Through Lines"



Grade V students recently took a journey around the globe—without leaving the classroom! As a part of their geography lesson, they learned about longitudes and latitudes and how these imaginary lines help us locate places on Earth. Through an engaging hands-on activity, students created their own world maps and marked important lines such as the Equator, Prime Meridian, Tropic of Cancer, and Tropic of Capricorn. They practiced finding coordinates and locating countries using this Global Grid System. This activity sparked curiosity about world geography and helped students develop map-reading and analytical skills in a fun and interactive way.



Mapping Our Daily Journey: Explore Navigation Through Landmarks

Students of Grade VI recently embarked on an engaging map-making activity, where they created detailed maps tracing their journey from home to school using prominent landmarks. This hands-on project not only enhanced their spatial awareness but also deepened their understanding of geography and navigation.



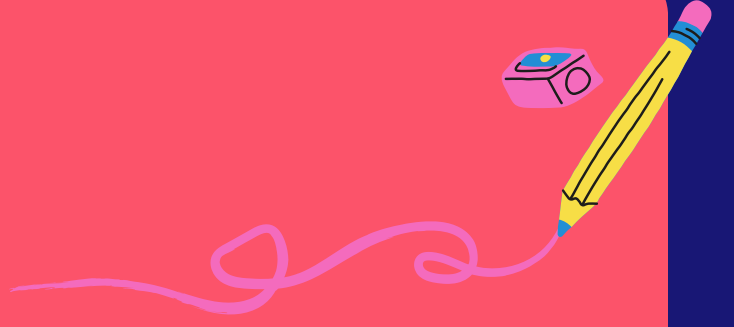
